



Maserati Owners Club UAE

Membership Rules & Regulations

1.0 Purpose:

- (1.1) The purpose of the Maserati Club UAE (MC-UAE) is to develop, foster, and promote the ownership of Maserati motor vehicles in the UAE through the organization and conduct of motor vehicle meetings, drives, and social events.

2.0 Application for membership

- (2.1) To apply to become a member of the Maserati Club UAE, a person must submit a written application to the club which states the applicant
- (2.1a) Is the rightful owner of a Maserati Vehicle; and
- (2.1b) wishes to become a member of the Association; and
- (2.1c) supports the purposes of the Association; and
- (2.1d) agrees to comply with these Rules.

3.0 General rights of members

- (3.1) A member of the Club has the right
- (3.1a) to receive notice of general meetings and of proposed special events
- (3.1b) to submit items of business/proposition for consideration at a general meeting; and
- (3.1c) to attend and be heard at general meetings/events.

4.0 Termination of membership

- (4.1) Grounds for Termination from the Club
- (4.2) The membership of a person ceases on resignation, death, or expulsion by the following:
- (4.2a) Unable to follow the General Rules of Conduct.
- (4.2b) Religious or racial intolerance
- (4.2c) Failure to attend multiple meetings or sponsored events.
- (4.2d) Reckless/careless driving resulting in endangerment to participants or others.
- (4.3) MC-UAE reserve the right to terminate any persons membership at any given time due to violating these rules and regulations without given notice.
- (4.4) If a person ceases to be a member of the Association, the Secretary must, as soon as practicable, enter the date the person ceased to be a member in the register of members.

5.0 Resigning as a member

- (5.1) A member may resign by notice in writing given to the Association.
- (5.2) A member is taken to have resigned if
- (5.2a) The Club has made a written request to the member to confirm that he or she wishes to remain a member; and the member has not, within 2 months after receiving that request, confirmed in writing that he or she wishes to remain a member.

6.0 Register of members

- (6.1) The Club must keep and maintain a register of members that includes for each current member
- (6.1a) the member's name;
- (6.1b) the address for notice last given by the member;
- (6.1c) the date of becoming a member;
- (6.1d) the type of membership
- (6.1e) any other information determined by the Founders
- (6.1f) for each former member, the date of ceasing to be a member.
- (6.2) Any member may, at a reasonable time and free of charge, may inspect or request to update their information maintained in the register.

7.0 Annual general meetings

- (7.1) The Maserati Club UAE must convene a minimum of 1 general meeting per year.
- (7.2) With exception to rule (7.1), the club may hold its first annual general meeting at any time within 18 months after its incorporation.
- (7.3) The Committee may suggest the date, time and place of the annual general meeting and propose to the founders for approval.
- (7.4) The ordinary business of the annual general meeting is as follows
- (7.4a) to confirm the discussion of the previous annual general meeting and of any special general meeting held since then;
- (7.4b) to receive and consider proposed events for the following year.
- (7.5) The annual general meeting may also conduct any other business of which notice has been given in accordance with these Rules.

8.0 General Events:

- (8.1) It is not mandatory for members to participate in events/meetings however it is highly recommended
- (8.1a) Members are fully responsible for their guests and their own safety during all club activities
- (8.2) Non-registered participants may attend free meetings/events as long as they are accompanied by a registered member or obtain approval from the event organizer prior to the event. These members will be considered as guests.
- (8.2a) Members wishing to bring guests to a sponsored event must first obtain approval from the club prior to the event
- (8.2b) Any additional cost bared by the inclusion of a guest will be the accompanied member's responsibility.
- (8.3) The Founders reserve the right of final decision to all matters relating to the conducts of club meetings and events.
- (8.3a) The founders reserve the right to cancel, amend dates or times of events/meetings for the benefit to the majority of the club.
- (8.4) Members should attend meets in the vehicles they have registered with the club.

9.0 Special general meetings

- (9.1) Any general meeting of the Association, other than an annual general meeting or a disciplinary appeal meeting, is a special general meeting.
- (9.2) The Committee may convene a special general meeting whenever it thinks fit.

10.0 Special general meeting held at request of members

- (10.1) These meetings will be considered as non-official meetings and do not require the attendance of the committee members.
- (10.1a) Members may wish to meet each other on their own terms and schedule, the Club will bare no association or responsibility of these meetings.
- (10.1b) Such meetings will not show record on the event calendar or be coordinated by the committee members.

11.0 Sponsored Events

- (11.1) Events that are paid for by sponsors require event registration prior to the event date. All members shall be registered on first come first serve basis for limited participation events.
- (11.1a) Given there is not enough spots available a waitlist will be acquired.
- (11.2) In the event a registered member is unable to attend a sponsored event they are required to provide notification to a committee member.
- (11.2a) In the event a member does not show to a sponsored event and did not provide enough notice they may be penalized under Rule 4.2c

12.0 Notice requirements

- (12.1) Any notice required to be given to a member or a committee member under these Rules may be given
- (12.1a) by handing the notice to the member personally; or
- (12.1b) by sending it by post to the member at the address recorded for the member on the register of members; or
- (12.1c) by email, or facsimile, SMS, or any other electronic transmission.
- (12.2) Notice requirement does not apply to notice given under rule 4.3

13.0 General Conduct

- (13.1) All members should respect local laws and promote safe driving practices.
- (13.2) Any observations of member misconduct should be reported to the organizers or Club Committee members who possess the right to issue warning or dismissal of any member from event activities if found to be in violation of the Club rules and regulations.
- (13.3) Note: The club shall remain free of charge for members until a predetermined number of members has joined
- (13.4) The consumption of alcohol is prohibited during events and meets. Any members arriving intoxicated will be requested to leave and potential retribution may occur.
- (13.5) Members must follow the club guidelines and procedures at all times during Club activities
- (13.6) Respectful clothing must be worn at all times during Club events.
- (13.7) MC UAE has the right to share and post any photo or video taken during the club activities
- (13.7a) Members must respect others privacy when taking pictures or videos and avoid tagging members in photos without obtaining prior consent from that party.
- (13.8) Littering during events and meetings is prohibited. Please do your part to keep our environment and events clean of debris.

14.0 Alteration of Rules and Regulations

- (14.1) These Rules and Regulations may only be altered by a written proposal from the committee members and approved revision by the Club Founders.
